IT IS alleged that you have committed an offense against the State of Florida on or about **09/06/2011**, to wit: **CRUELTY TO ANIMALS - FELONY; CRUELTY TO ANIMALS; CRUELTY TO ANIMALS; CRUELTY TO ANIMALS**, in violation of Florida Statute(s). After an investigation of the offense(s) and your background, it appears that the interests of the State of Florida, and your own best interests will be served by the following procedures:

THEREFORE: On the authority of Jeffrey A. Siegmeister, State Attorney in and for the Third Judicial Circuit, **MADISON** County, Florida, prosecution in this matter for said offense(s) will be deferred for a term of **24 MONTHS**, from the date of signing this Agreement by the State Attorney or his assistant, provided that you abide by the following conditions:


1. You shall not violate any criminal law.
2. You shall work regularly, unless disabled, retired, or a full time student.
3. You shall notify the Diversion Programs Administrator of residence changes, as directed.
4. You shall pay **\$1200.00 state costs plus \$500.00 felony administrative costs**, to the State Attorney's Office, as directed.
5. You shall pay **\$40.00 court costs** to the Madison County Clerk of Courts, and provide a receipt of payment to the Diversion Program Administrator, as directed.
6. You shall pay **\$50.00 Public Defender application fee** to the Madison County Clerk of Courts, and provide a receipt of payment to the Diversion Programs Administrator.
7. You shall continue counseling and medications as prescribed and provide periodic progress reports to the Diversion Program Administrator.
8. You shall comply with the Madison Co. ordinance with regard to the maximum number of domestic animals permitted.
9. Pretrial Diversion may terminate early after 12 months if all conditions have been completed successfully.


DURING THE PERIOD of deferred prosecution, if you violate any of the conditions of this Agreement, the State Attorney may either commence prosecution of the offense(s), or modify and/or extend the period of deferred prosecution;


THE PARTIES stipulate and agree that this Agreement is a deferral of prosecution and not a contract of immunity. Should you fail to meet the conditions of this Agreement, the Agreement shall be void at the discretion of the State Attorney, and prosecution may then be instituted.



JEFFREY A. SIEGMEISTER, State Attorney, Third Judicial Circuit, by and through his undersigned Assistant, hereby warrants and agrees that provided you, the defendant, CRAIG A GRANT, fully meet the conditions of this Agreement, as determined by the State Attorney, the charge(s) referred to herein shall be dismissed. It is stipulated that the State Attorney's decision regarding full compliance in this regard shall not be reviewable by any Court.

By signing this Agreement, you withdraw and/or waive your right to a speedy trial under the constitution and laws of Florida and the United States, in the cause for which prosecution is being deferred. In addition, for purposes of this Program, you admit guilt of the offense(s) charged, and recognize that said admission could be used as evidence against you in event of prosecution.
